



THE FIVE LOVE LANGUAGES: FAITH

SERMON STUDY GUIDE

The "love" chapter of the Bible ends with the statement, "faith, hope and love, these three abide." Do we know what faith is? What does it mean to say it is the "assurance of things hoped for?" How do we know if we are feeling it? Faith is one of the top three in New Testament theology. Let's see if we can better understand what it is & means today.

First Step - Read Scripture

1 Corinthians 13

Matthew 17:19-20

Hebrews 11:1

- Step In -

Read 1 Corinthians 13. This passage thoroughly discusses love, showing both positive and negative expressions. How do those examples help you better understand love?

Look at v. 2. This verse says, "and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing." Discuss the relationship of love and faith in that verse.

- Step Up -

How would you describe faith?

How do you understand faith and how do you live it out?

How did the sermon relate faith and love?

- Step Out -

Read Matthew 17:20 and discuss the meaning of the verse for you. What are some ways that might help to grow your faith.

How might this small group help you grow in faith?

Ben Stein has said, "Faith is not believing that God can. It is knowing that God will." What does that say to you about faith and assurance?

Read Hebrews 11:1 and close in prayer.
