Step Up	<p>Share an episode or event in your life when you felt hectic and overwhelmed.</p> <p>How did living as an apprentice of Jesus help you work through the difficulty? Or.....what prevented you from expressing God through your actions?</p> <p>How, if at all, would you have handled the situation differently in retrospect?</p>
Step Out	<p>Knowing that growing in our ability to live intuitively depends on how willing we are to “be still” and listen and respond to God’s direction, what are some steps we can take to be more “tuned in” to God?</p> <p>What must we proactively, intentionally DO?</p> <p>What must we proactively, intentionally AVOID?</p>
