



Trip Guidelines for Students

Hotel/Cabin Behavior:

- Do not run in the halls or slam doors closed
- Stay quiet in rooms. Please be courteous of other guests
- Never come out of rooms after lights out
- There will be no wandering around the facility or jumping on the beds
- No males in female rooms or females in male rooms (you will be sent home immediately)

Anona Dress Code:

- All clothing should be appropriate and respectful
- All clothing needs to cover midriff, low back, chest, side, and bottom
- No short-shorts. Standard Anona Rule: 2in. minimum inseam
- See-through, revealing, or mesh garments must not be worn without appropriate coverage underneath
- Clothing may not be worn with unsuitable writings, pictures, suggestive decorations, or other imprints that are questionable taste or could be offensive

General Swimsuit Guidelines

- Only full coverage top & bottom swimsuits
- No speedos or boxers visible
- Keep in mind the activities we will be doing and dress accordingly

Miscellaneous Items:

- Electronics and cell phones are not allowed on trips
- Students must stay in at least groups of three at all times
 - o Middle schoolers must also stay with an adult

- Foul language or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated
- Lights out, means lights out. Everything should be done beforehand
- Do not borrow money from other students; see your group leader
