- Support and uplift our two Traditional Sunday worship services through inspirational and well-prepared organ and piano music including preludes, postludes, hymns and other special music as needed.
- Provide accompaniment support for the weekly Wednesday night Choir rehearsal.
- Provide accompaniment support for a weekly Traditional ensemble rehearsal.
- Accompany soloists in worship, including rehearsal and preparation time.

- Serve as keyboard accompanist for our seasonal orchestra, which prepares and plays for Advent, Christmas Eve, Holy Week, Easter, and other Sundays as scheduled.
- Provide accompaniment support for additional Traditional worship groups and ensembles as needed.
- Prepare music for weddings, funerals, and other special events and services.
